<p><u>Intent</u></p> <p>At Sandringham and West Newton and Flitcham Primary Academies, we have constructed a ‘catch-up’ plan to ensure children catch up on any lost learning time and potential gaps in knowledge. This plan will focus on quality first teaching, empowering our team of tutors by providing high quality training, specific year group ‘gap’ filling, classroom intervention and small group targeted support with the child’s health and well-being at the centre of all we do.</p>	<p><u>Actions</u></p> <p><u>1</u></p>	<p><u>Implementation</u> Carry out PIXL assessments to identify gaps/learning needs.</p>	
	<p><u>2</u></p>	<p>Staff to identify pupils who would benefit from extra tuition – those that might make rapid progress. Analysis of PIXL Autumn transition package and teacher assessment/ plus additional info later from end of Autumn assessment used to informed groups/1:1</p>	
	<p><u>3</u></p>	<p>Analysis of class/ pupil need by staff to identify which children and strategies/support would be appropriate. Broken down into different waves of support. Wave 1 – whole class, Wave 2 – groups, Wave 3 - 1:1</p>	
	<p><u>4</u></p>	<p>TA and teaching staff work together to deliver catch up using precision teaching and PIXL interventions. (Nov 2020)</p>	
	<p><u>Impact</u></p> <p>Children will make at least expected or accelerated progress in identified key areas of learning. Staff will have the necessary skills and resources to identify and teach pupils in need of support.</p>	<p><u>5</u></p>	<p>Children in need of additional teacher tutoring to be identified and NTP accessed as needed. (Jan 2021)</p>
<p><u>6</u></p>		<p>TA and class timetables to be finalised that identify when catch up sessions will take place over Spring and summer term.</p>	
<p><u>7</u></p>		<p>Pre and post intervention assessments to be carried out.</p>	
<p><u>8</u></p>		<p>SLT monitoring to take place every 3 weeks in SLT meeting time.</p>
