Important Information Regarding Contact Tracing Over Half Term

Should your child develop symptoms of Coronavirus within 48 hours of school closing for half term and subsequently receive a positive test notification of this should be promptly reported by email to head@flitcham.norfolk.sch.uk. Your email should include the date the symptoms started, the last day your child attended school, the date the test was taken and the date of the positive result. Monitoring of this email address will take place until 5pm on Thursday 3rd June to allow time for test results to be received. After 3:30pm on Friday 28th May the phone line and the office email address office@flitcham.norfolk.sch.uk will **NOT** be monitored until Monday 7th June therefore it is important you send your email to head@flitcham.norfolk.sch.uk.

You only need to make contact if symptoms develop on or before Sunday 30th May and a positive test is then received. For symptoms after this date resulting in a positive test you would need to follow NHS test and trace guidelines. Should you need to book a test please call 119 to book or go to NHS.uk/coronavirus.

Should we receive notification of a positive test we will notify you by email using the email address we hold on file for all other communication. Any email sent will contain full instructions on what you should do.

We ask that you only make contact using head@flitcham.norfolk.sch.uk for positive COVID tests and that all other matters are communicated from Monday 7th June or sent to office@flitcham.norfolk.sch.uk to be picked up on Monday 7th June.
