Homework will be sent out each Tuesday it should be completed and returned the following Monday. It's very helpful for children in KS2 to get in the habit of taking time to complete their homework and hand it in as this is a useful skill for secondary school. I would also expect children to read for at least 2 hours over the week as part of their homework, this should be recorded in reading logs.

Children should continue to practise their timestables as this underpins their maths knowledge in many mathematical areas. They should be using Tackling Tables. Remember, all the children have a log-in to the Tackling Tables App and are welcome to log-in and practice any time.

You also have login detail for letter- join which you could use to support English work. Children will also have spellings in their spelling logs to work on as well as the common exception words which have already come home.
